Formal processes concerning slavery and human trafficking have been established, including disciplinary procedures where they are breached. This policy is regularly reviewed by the Directors to ensure its continuing suitability and relevance to the company activities.

The Company will achieve these aims by our initiative to identify and mitigate risk in the following ways (But not limited to):-

• More stringent vetting and investigation of our supply chain (contractors, sub-contractors, policies, contracts etc.).

• Continually audit & review our practices for checking all employees are paid at least the minimum wage and have the right to work;

• We encourage the reporting of concerns and the protection of whistle blowers.

• The company will not knowingly support or deal with any business involved in slavery or human trafficking.

• We have zero tolerance to slavery and human trafficking. We expect all those in our supply chain and contractors comply with our values. All Directors have been briefed on the subject.

This policy is in accordance with Section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes our company's slavery and human trafficking statement.
