2012/19 Directive of Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment (WEEE)

RE: 2015/863 Directive on Restriction of use of Certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS)

Guy-Raymond do not manufacture electrical or electronic equipment and therefore Directive 2012/19 does not apply directly to any of the products supplied by us.

To the best of our knowledge all products manufactured and supplied by Guy-Raymond are in compliance with the requirements of EU Directive 2011/65/EU on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment also known as "RoHS 2" and as amended by directive 2015/863 (RoSH3) with the below exemptions applied.

Exceptions:

- 6(a)-I: *Lead as an alloying element in steel for machining purposes containing up to 0.35% lead by weight **
- 6(c): *Copper alloy containing up to 4% lead by weight***

*We are aware of the ongoing ECHA review into the RoSH lead exemptions and aware that the extension applied to exemption 6(a) is due to expire on 21 July 2024 and for **6(c) is due to expire on 21 July 2026.

We are monitoring the situation closely to ensure that Guy-Raymond is compliant with relevant legislation.
